



Obligation and prohibition :



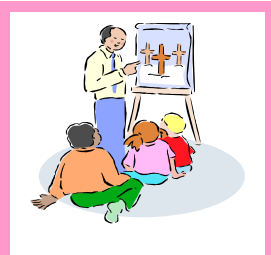
Subject + have to + verb

 → Express prohibition.

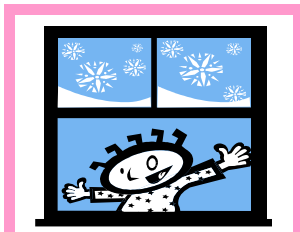
Complete with must/ mustn't /don't / have to:



Youwork hard at school. You work hard it's a rule.



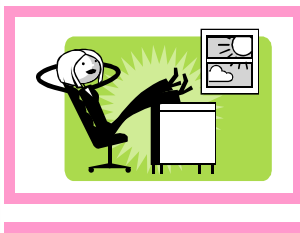
Youlisten to your teacher carefully.



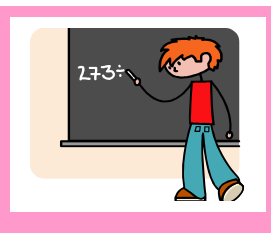
You look out of the window while the teacher is explaining the lesson



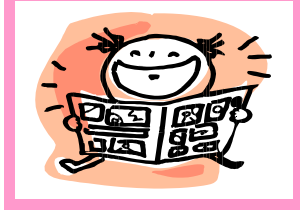
..... write on the desk. You keep your school clean.

Youbring your books



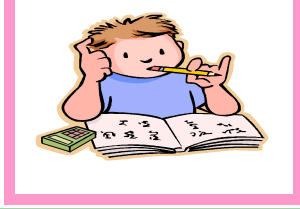
You sleep in the classroom.



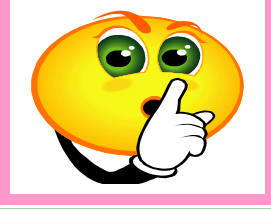
Youraise your hand before speaking in the classroom
